With brightness comes clarity and in the case of the Panova Grün, the scratch-resistant and anti-glare sapphire crystal in the watch's high quality stainless steel case ensures that you always have a clear view of the time. This impressive case is not only water-resistant up to 10 bars but also boasts a screw-in crown and a robust textile strap. All of these features make the Panova Grün perfectly equipped to be an ideal time measuring companion for everyday use, be it on a stroll through misty mountains or mossy landscapes.

In order to live up to its flawless appearance, the Panova Grün also offers quality with a capital Q on the inside thanks to its field-tested SW 200-1 Mühle version movement, which is equipped with the company's anniversary rotor and patented particularly shockproof woodpecker neck regulation. Once its components have been carefully finished and assembled, this movement is put to the test in six different positions and regulated to achieve accuracy values of between 0 and a maximum of +8 seconds per day. This precision target forms the heart of Mühle's very own regulation standards, which comply with the German chronometer standard and help to ensure that the watch never runs slow. After all, the ultimate priority at Mühle-Glashütte is making sure that its watch wearers are never too late because of their time measuring instruments.

Just like its predecessor, the Panova Grün not only stands out due to its meticulous watchmaking craftsmanship and top-quality features but also because it provides its wearers with a perfect watch-life balance. It is therefore the ideal companion for both greenhorns in the world of mechanical time measurement and experienced watch collectors who prefer long strolls through lush green forests

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over long working hours. One thing's for sure: the Panova Grün certainly lives up to its name. "Panova" is a combination of "panorama", which represents far-sightedness and perspective, and "via" meaning journey and by helping its wearer to always focus on the essential things in life and choose the right path, this new watch certainly does its name proud.

**Case:** Brushed stainless steel. Anti-glare sapphire crystal. Screw-in crown. Ø 40.0 mm; H 10.4 mm. Water-resistant to 10 bars. Textile or leather strap with a stainless steel pin buckle.

**Dial:** Green. Hour markers and hands coated in Super LumiNova.

We therefore regulate our watches so that they are always slightly fast, maintaining a precision of between 0 and a maximum of +8 seconds per day. This enables us to ensure that Mühle watch wearers are never too late because of their time measuring instruments.

Thilo Mühle places particularly high value on maintaining such high quality standards. He represents the fifth generation of the Mühle family to manage the independent family company from the German town of Glashütte. Robert Mühle laid the foundation for the development of Mühle-Glashütte in 1869,

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when he established a family company producing precise measuring instruments for the local clock and watch industry in Glashütte. It has been operating under the name of “Mühle-Glashütte GmbH nautische Instrumente und Feinmechanik” since 1994. Alongside its well-known collection of watches, the company also equips cruise ships and luxury yachts with its marine time systems and chronometers. By introducing the “R. Mühle & Sohn” manufacturing line in 2014, the family company from the town of Glashütte not only celebrated its 145th anniversary, but also cemented its status as a manufacturing workshop. With these elegant timepieces and self-developed movements, Mühle-Glashütte pays homage to the company's roots – the manufacturing workshop founded by Robert Mühle in the Saxon town of Glashütte.
